RE: CONSTITUENT ASSESSORS AND MODERATORS REGISTRATION

Dear Stakeholders,

Following the public consultation process on the Sector Education and Training Authority (SETA) landscape post 2020, the Minister of Higher Education, Science and Technology, Dr Blade Nzimande, has published the Gazette on the re-establishment of SETAs. The Minister has re-established 20 SETAs, including the Services SETA for the period 1 April 2020 to March 2030; aligned to the National Development Plan and the National Skills Development Plan.

To align to this landscape, the Services SETA has resolved the following in relation to registration end dates;

- Constituent assessors and moderators registered from 1 July 2018 to date will be extended for a 5 year period.
- Constituent assessors and moderators registered prior to 1 July 2018 must apply through the LMIS for registration.
- For the extension of scope the standard application process remains the same.

The assessors and moderators who are receiving an automatic extension will receive an updated report reflecting the 5 year period. The report can be downloaded from the Learner Management Information System (LMIS) once updated by the LMIS developers with the new end date reflecting. Those that need to re-apply must refer to the link below for further details on how to apply on the LMIS.
